

IMD - UNIFORM POLICY

Each Band member will be provided with a Marching Band Uniform, hanger, garment bag, hat, and hatbox. Men in Concert Band will be provided a tuxedo jacket & slacks, hanger, and garment bag.

Each piece of the uniform has a corresponding number in our records. It is the responsibility of the student to maintain his/her uniform in good condition and to be responsible for it while in their possession.

UNIFORM CARE

Hang the uniform neatly on its hanger and in its garment bag when not being worn. Do not store the shoes in the garment bag as this may soil the uniform. *Never wash the uniform!*

Do not alter the uniform without permission from the Uniform Coordinator.

SHOES: Inspection will be done before each performance
Wipe with a damp cloth and dry
Use a small amount of Vaseline
Buff to shine with a soft cloth

JACKET: Do not put anything in the pockets that will cause stains
Do not put anything in the pockets that might tear them
GAUNTLETS ARE EASY TO LOSE AND ARE YOUR SOLE RESPONSIBILITY. YOU WILL HAVE TO PAY TO REPLACE THEM IF THEY ARE LOST.

SLACKS: Have students wear pants with bib, marching shoes, and adjust suspenders.
Hemming Instructions:
Wearing full uniform (battery include harness), stand at attention.
Measure 1" from the ground. This is your hemline.

WHEN WEARING THE UNIFORM

A black t-shirt and Gym/Boxer shorts will be worn under the uniform at all times.
Jewelry is not allowed while in uniform
Remove any nail polish before wearing the uniform
Hair should be pulled back and off the nape of the neck.
Wear black socks only. Socks must come to mid-calf (no short socks).
Absolutely no white socks!
No eating or drinking in uniform.

UNIFORM COST

Each member must pay a \$ 100.00 UNIFORM FEE (see CVUSD - Uniform Maintenance Fund). This fee is paid to the District to cover the cost of maintenance, replacement, and cleaning. Students will be held responsible for the loss or damage of any part of the uniform or concert attire. Keep track of your gauntlets!

Students are asked to purchase Dinkles marching shoes and gloves. (Ladies not in Competitive Marching Band (CMB) do not need to buy marching shoes. Men & ladies not in CMB do not need to purchase gloves.) For Concert Band, men are required to purchase a tux shirt, bow tie, and Dinkles. Ladies are required to buy a Concert dress (to be ordered through the band). Everyone is required to purchase a pep-shirt; this is our casual dress uniform. All of the above items are required uniform items (see Apparel Order Form).
